5. Send this completed application with the appropriate fee in order to receive the sanction number. A sanction number will not be issued until this application, fee and meet announcement are received and reviewed.

Meet Announcement Required Information

Application for sanction must be accompanied by a copy of the complete meet announcement which must include the following:

- A. A statement about the nature of prizes to be awarded.
- B. A complete schedule of lanes and times for all warm-up procedures which must be adhered to by all participants.
- C. Information about water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls.
- D. The following statement: "Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. "
- E. A statement that no swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.
- F. A statement indicating whether on-deck registration will be permitted and under what conditions.
- G. One of the following two statements:
 - 1. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming; or
 - 2. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
- H. The following statement: "Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms."
- I. The following statement: "Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged."
- J. The following statement: "Held under the sanction of USA Swimming and Louisiana Swimming, Inc."
- K. The following statement: "It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Louisiana Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event."

At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.

All meet directors, referees, starters, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity must be members of USA Swimming.

All coaches and officials MUST constantly display their current USA Swimming credential or be prepared to present their USA Swimming ID card as proof of their registration to the Meet Director or designee at any time. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credential display and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid or current.

Eligibility:

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302.
