

LOUISIANA SWIMMING
GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
MINUTES
OCTOBER 2, 2005

The meeting was called to order by Ed Kelly, General Chairman in Shreveport at 10:10 AM. He thanked all teams for opening their doors to all displaced swimmers in the State. Due to Hurricane Katrina only three representatives were able to attend this years convention. A MOTION was made and SECONDED to accept the minutes as posted. MOTION PASSED.

Jack Jordan reported that there are still problems with times unless entries are correct and data bases are the same. Make sure that hand entries are correct. Relays must be complete and split times must be present on the final results in order for those times to be entered in the data base. There is a fee of \$2.00 to transfer a swimmer along with a completed transfer form. Check the web-site for instructions on the 120 rule for displaced swimmers.

Warren Lind sent in a report stating that the travel fund and finances are in good shape and there is no need for any changes at this time.

Colleen Barczk reported that there will be a push for different types of meets and longer events with more points being awarded for the longer events. Information was given on IMX swimming. August 1-5th is the Zone Meet, Sectionals will be at Texas A&M March 2-5th (open), and University of Houston on August 26-30th.(closed).
